Kapalua Resort's Mahana Ridge Trail Temporarily Closing

KAPALUA RESORT, MAUI, HAWAII – The Kapalua Resort Association announces that the Mahana Ridge Trail will be temporarily closed to all hiking beginning Monday, February 18, 2013. The trail closure is necessitated by the construction of Mahana Estates which has made the area unsafe to hikers. The trail will reopen in approximately six to eight weeks once construction in the area is complete.

The Maunalei Arboretum Trail will remain open and hikers may contact the Kapalua Shuttle to make reservations on the shuttle to and from the trail head. The following schedule is in effect for the Arboretum Shuttle:

Maunalei Arboretum Shuttle

9:30 AM	Pick-up at Kapalua Village Center for trip to Arboretum
11:30 AM	Pick-up at Kapalua Village Center for trip to Arboretum
11:50 AM	Pick-up at Arboretum and return to Kapalua Village Center
1:50 PM	Pick-up at Arboretum and return to Kapalua Village Center
