

Kapalua Shuttle Service Modifications Effective January 1, 2016

Aloha,

As of January 1, 2016 the Kapalua Shuttle will be modifying its hours and area of operation in order to better serve the needs of our Kapalua Resort residents and guests.

Hours of operation:

7:00 AM to 11:00 PM with last call for service at 10:45 PM.

Area of operation:

Shuttle service will no longer be provided to the Kapalua/West Maui Airport and the Maunalei Arboretum. Service will continue to be provided to all businesses and residences within the Kapalua Resort.

Hikers wishing to visit the Maunalei Arboretum will still be able to access it from the Mahana Ridge Trail from the Kapalua Village Center or D.T. Flemings Beach. Please note, this is a strenuous 17 mile hike round-trip, so hikers should be advised to dress appropriately, carry adequate water and nutrition, and be mindful of hazardous weather conditions. No return transportation from the trailhead above Plantation Estates and Honolua Ridge will be provided. No private vehicles are permitted to drive to the trailhead as the roadway is private property with no public access allowed.

Residents and guests in need of transportation to and from the Kapalua/West Maui Airport should contact a private transportation provider or taxi company.
